
## EMBED A VIDEO IN A PROJECT ARTICLE PAGE

First, in order to embed a video into the project article page, you need the embed code. For example, you can find this under the “share” option for a YouTube video.



Now, once you've copied the embed code for the video, go to the project you are working on.

If it doesn't open up to the "article" page, click on the "article" tab.




Then click on the, "Edit Article" button.




Locate the place in the article page that you want to embed the video and take note of the text surrounding it.

This will be important for finding the correct spot in the HTML code.


To edit the HTML code, click on the “HTML” button in the toolbar.




An “HTML Source Editor” pops up.  
This is where you will paste the embed code.



Now, find the spot you want to embed the video and paste the embed code by right-clicking and choosing, "paste."



Then click, "update."



Now you should see the video embedded into the article page.
