





How to Map a Project on Bay-Delta Live



First, login to your account by clicking on the Login link at the top of the homepage.




Next, click on the “Projects” link in the top bar to go to the project library.




It opens up to the “What’s New” tab. Click on “Search & List View” in the sub-navigation to go to the full project library.




Find the project you’d like to edit and hover over the Tools button until a drop-down menu appears. Choose, “edit.”




The metadata editor form pops up. This is where you can enter or edit the metadata of a project.




Click on the “Map It!” tab.




You can enter the latitude and longitude coordinates of the project location.




If you don't have the specific coordinates, click "Open Map" to use the map function to select the location.



Once you select a location on the map, the latitude and longitude coordinates will show in the form.



Click "save changes."



As long as your project is public, it will show up on the map so people can search using geolocation.
